



For our hymn sing in July I included some information on the hymns. Hymns are a vital and meaningful part of our spiritual biography. These are three of the hymns we will sing in September. I hope you enjoy the information.

For the Beauty of the Earth #879 - Words..Folliott S. Pierpont (1835-1917) Music..Conrad Kueher 1786-1872

This hymn reminds us of the common blessings of life that many of us take for granted - the beauties of nature, our parents, family, friends and church.

Pierpont wrote this hymn for the Communion Service but its adequacy as a Communion hymn has been obscured by editors who changed the refrain from "Christ, our God, to thee we raise this our sacrifice of praise" to Lord of all, to thee we raise this our hymn of grateful praise." However, this hymn has such an acceptable lyric of joy to the beauties of eye and ear, heart and mind, that no hymnal can omit it.

O Master Let Me Walk With You (originally Thee) #818 words.. Washington Gladden (1838 - 1918), Music..H. Percy Smith (1825-1898)

Washington Gladden was a American Congregationalist born in Pennsylvania and a graduate of Williams College. He was known as one of the most powerful preachers in the country.

Gladden wrote this as a poem that was meant to be a meditation. The hymn represents the high-water mark of religious poetry. It contains no challenging theology out of the past, only a yearning for that constant companionship with the Master, hoping for the presence of Christ in all life's relationships and decisions.

Oh, Worship the King #842 words..Sir Robert Grant (1779-1838) music..William Croft (1678-1727)

Sir Robert Grant was Scottish, Anglican. He was born in India where is father had gone as a young man and became a member of the Board of Trade, the was elected to Parliament after returning to Scotland. Sir Robert became a director of the East India Company, a member of Parliament and finally Governor of Bombay. He enjoyed writing but wrote little. This is the only hymn of 12 that he wrote that has survived.

Oh, Worship the King is based on Psalm 104 which has an impassioned description of the Creator and His works. In the hymn the descriptions are a bit more general but with strong emotional content: God-King, Shield, Defender, Ancient of Days, Maker, Redeemer and Friend. This hymn combines the majestic, the tender and a smooth-flowing poetical rendering.
